Participants coming from countries outside the ECOWAS region are advised to **obtain visas before traveling to The Gambia.** Arrangements are being made for participants coming from countries in which the Republic of The Gambia does not have diplomatic representation to be issued visas upon arrival at Banjul International Airport, or at other points of entry, upon presentation of this letter of invitation to the Session.

Participants are also advised to take the necessary vaccinations, and to travel with their vaccination cards.

NHRIs wishing to speak on any of the Agenda items are strictly advised to inform the Secretariat of the ACHPR in advance, and to submit their papers/ contributions, to the latter not later than two (2) weeks prior to the Session. This is a pre-condition to being granted permission to speak during the Sessions.
